GeoTask is an information gathering app which records the movements of those individuals who voluntarily sign up to take part, via the use of a GPS signal from their mobile device. It is then possible to map movement patterns and 'dwell times' around a town. The operators hope that a minimum of 200 volunteers in any given town will start to provide useful data. The value of the data improves with the number of participants. Many local towns are also participating (Stockport was an early starter) and volunteers' information will be gathered in any participating town – so the number of towns involved will also improve the data set. It is hoped that the information will be of use to existing businesses but also used to attract new tenants to vacant units by demonstrating patterns of movement and footfall.

5. Expenditure & Funding:

The initiative is free for the first twelve months (year 1). Information collected by GeoTask is likely to be charged for in year 2. VB will review the value of the data and either pay for this as a benefit to members (if access to data is seen as an incentive to membership), by asking members to pay a contribution to obtain the data or will cease participation in the scheme.

6. Timescale:

Roughly calendar year 2016 is year 1. Continued involvement will be subject to VB decision. Individuals can unsubscribe at any time.

7. Town Team Involvement:
