



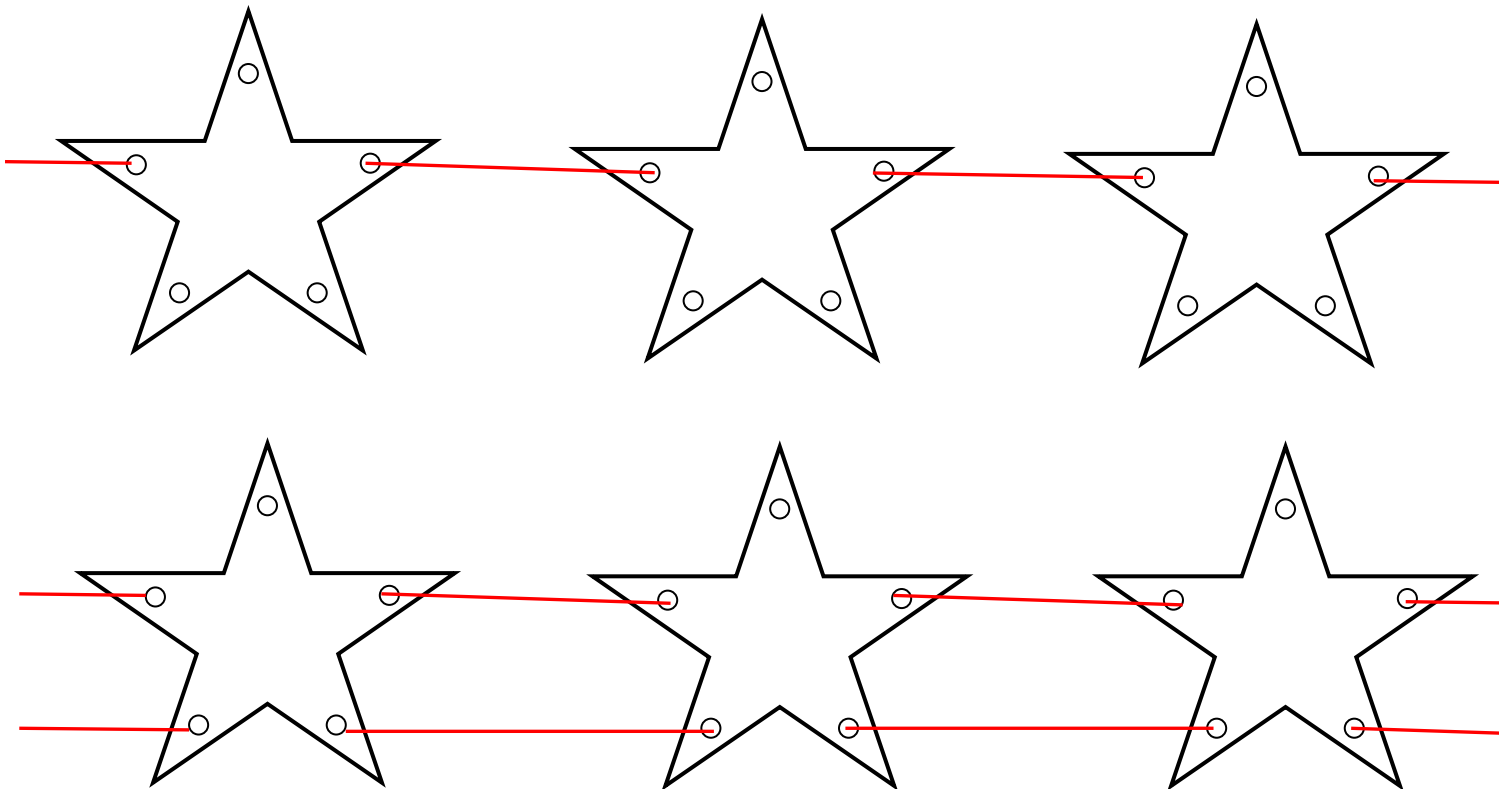
## How To: *Make Star Garlands from milk containers*

- Materials:**
- Empty plastic milk containers
  - Scissors
  - Star template (see next page)
  - Biro or fine marker pen
  - Hole punch
  - Thin, strong ribbon or, white cord



### Steps:

1. Remove the label and cut the bottom off the milk bottle
2. Cut the top off the container, just below the handle joint, to form a tube
3. Slit the tube open down one side
4. Lay it out flat, don't worry if it is slightly curly
5. Place the sheet on top of the star template (next page), decide which size you are going to use and trace using either a biro or fine marker pen
6. After cutting the first star, you could use that one as your template
7. Once you have cut your stars, they can be all one size or several, punch holes in each point
8. String together the stars at intervals, ready to hang, using either one or two strings. Either knot between each hole to prevent slippage or, loop the continuous thread through twice to hold.
